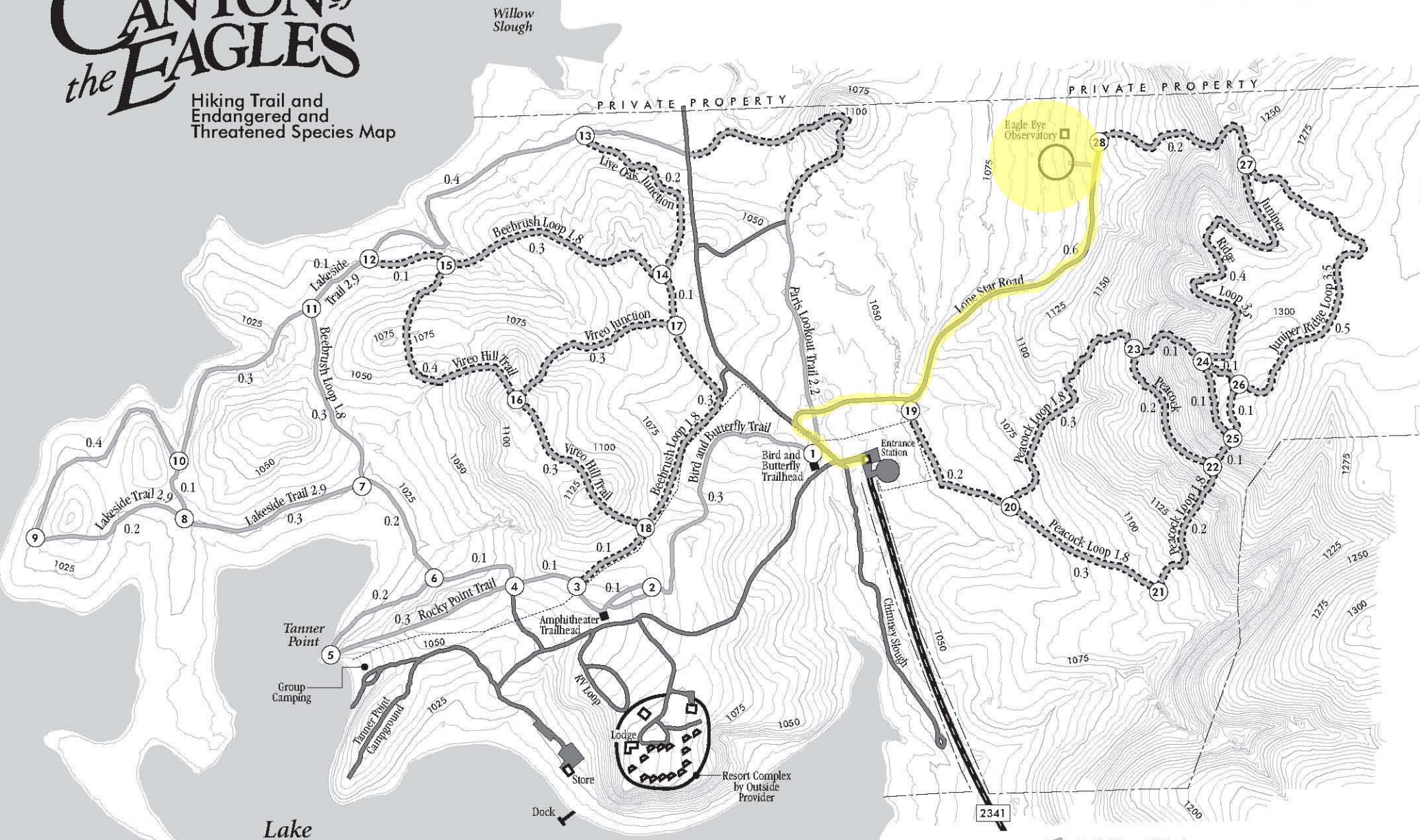
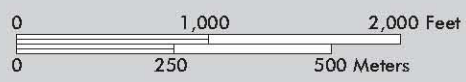


CANYON of the EAGLES
